As you may know, Lunenburg received the designation as a World Heritage site from UNESCO in 1995. *The Town of Lunenburg is our Campus*. Our courses are based at our School, located in the heart of Old Town Lunenburg as shown on map attached.

Courses: all courses run from 10am – 4pm, Monday thru Friday, inclusive, unless otherwise advised.

Materials: please refer to individual course information for any materials you may be required to bring. Materials may be purchased at Printer's Corner (1-902-624-0170), 10 minutes away at the 4-way STOP in Blockhouse.

Dining: there are numerous cafes and restaurants within walking distance of our School. We have a standard size refrigerator to store the lunch you may bring.

Smoking: our School and our neighbours are housed in historic wooden buildings, thus smoking is not permitted in and around our premises.

Registration: you are considered to be registered for a course offered by our School once you have completed our enrollment form and fully paid the respective course and materials fees.

Cancellation:

1. If a cancellation is received by our School prior to 30 days before a course start date, course and material fees will be refunded, less a \$50.00 cancellation fee.
2. There is no refund of fees if a cancellation is made within 30 days of your course start date.

NSF Cheques: our School shall charge a \$25.00 service fee on any NSF cheque.
